- 1) In what year was the first Book of Common Prayer published in the USA?

  1789 (found on page 8)
- 2) When does the church calendar begin?

The first Sunday of Advent (p. 31, p. 888)

3) What are the seven principal feast days of the church year?

Easter Day, Ascension Day, the Day of Pentecost, Trinity Sunday, All Saints' Day, Christmas Day, the Epiphany (p. 15)

4) When was the first BCP written?

1549 (p. 866)

- 5) List the four ways the Psalms may be said or sung. What do we do at Trinty?

  Direct Recitation (occasionally used at Trinity)

  Antiphonal Recitation

  Responsorial Recitation

  Responsive Recitation (primarily used at Trinity) -- p 582
- 6) The Lectionary is arranged in a three year cycle. What page of the BCP will you find the formula for determining if a given year is year A, B or C?

  p888 Year evenly divisible by 3 is A (e.g. 2019 divided by 3 = 673 so Advent 2019 begins year A)
- 7) Is 2020 a year A, B or C?

Most of 2020 is year A, because year A began in Advent 2019. In Advent 2020, we will begin year B.

8) What is the earliest possible date for Easter? The latest date?

March 22, April 25 (found on p. 15)

- 9) What is the primary Gospel reading for year A, B or C? Where did you find it?
  - A: Matthew, B: Mark, C: Luke; found on p. 271 or 273
- 10) What are the names of the three creeds printed in the BCP? When do we say them?

Apostles, Nicene, Athanasian. We use the Apostles Creed in Morning Prayer (and Baptism), the Nicene Creed in the Eucharist
