It means that we are free to make choices: to love, to create, to reason, and to live in harmony with creation and with God. (found on p. 845)

3) Is there a prayer for church musicians? If so where?

On page 819

4) How many forms of Holy Eucharist are there? Which one are you most familiar with?

Two (Rite I and Rite II) Or six (counting Eucharistic Prayer I & 2 in Rite I, and Eucharistic Prayers A, B, C, and D in Rite II separately). Three or eight can also be justified if you read far enough to discover Forms 1 & 2 in "An Order for Celebrating the Holy Eucharist, pp 400-405.

5) List the first six words of the Contemporary Collect for the last Sunday after the Epiphany.

O God, who before the Passion... (page 217)

6) Who may hear one's confession?

Any Christian, but only a bishop or priest may pronounce absolution. Page 446

7) Where and when may one's confession be heard?

Any time and any where. Page 446

8) What is the Gospel reading for Good Friday?

John 18:1-19:42 (page 277 or 893 or 904 or 915)

9) On what page in the BCP could you find a prayer to use at someone's birthday celebration?

10) On what page in the BCP could you find a prayer of Thanksgiving for the Gift of a Child?
