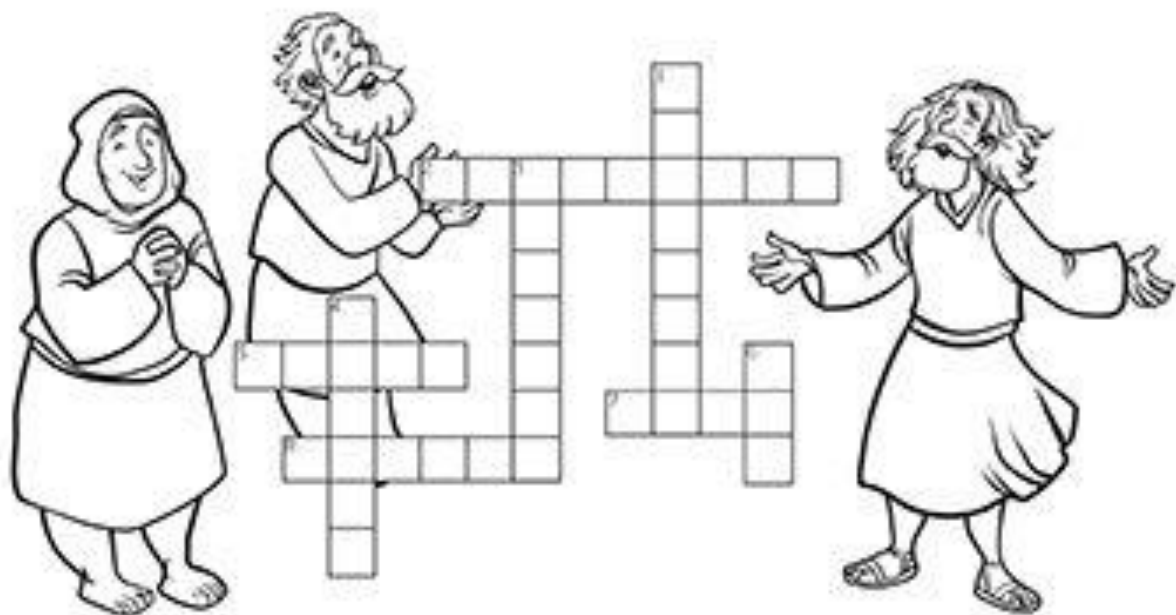


# JESUS GIVES THANKS
