He has won a number of organ competitions and performed hundreds of concerts throughout the United States and Europe, both solo as well as part of the AE Meyer flute & organ duo. His instrumental and choral compositions have won awards, and he is the composer of the new Johns Hopkins University school song.



He is currently the organist at Abington Presbyterian Church and adjunct faculty at Temple University.
