## TODAY'S RECITALIST

Wesley Parrott is a resident of Philadelphia and serves as Organist at Philadelphia Episcopal Cathedral where he collaborated on the design of the recently installed Moeller organ, opus 6425. He also serves Liturgical Musician at St. Francis de Sales Roman Catholic Church in Philadelphia. His recordings are available through the Organ Historical Society. Wesley has served the Executive Committee of the Philadelphia Chapter of the AGO and is a past president of The Franklin Inn Club, Philadelphia. He also served as a regular Assistant Organist performing on the Macy's Grand Court Wanamaker Organ, Philadelphia, for daily recitals and radio broadcasts.



He holds degrees from the Curtis Institute of Music, the University of the South, and Eastman School of Music, University of Rochester, and has served as organist for churches in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (St Mark's Episcopal Church, St. Mary's Episcopal Church Cathedral Road), in Alexandria, Virginia (The Old Presbyterian Meeting House), in Washington, D.C. (New York Avenue Presbyterian Church and Church of the Epiphany), and in Rochester, New York (St. Stanislaus Kostka Roman Catholic Church). Winner of three US national organ playing competitions in 1979 (Ottumwa Iowa, Fort Wayne and Mader), he was also a finalist in the International Organ Playing Competition, Grand Prix de Chartres in 1982, and a semi-finalist in 1986.

Wesley has performed in such places as Longwood Gardens, Ocean Grove, New Jersey, the Kennedy Center, Washington National Cathedral, the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, National City Christian Church (Washington, D.C.), The Kimmel Center's Verizon Hall, the Academy of Music (Philadelphia), Princeton University Chapel, St. Vincent Archabbey (Latrobe, Pennsylvania), the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception (Washington, D.C.), Chartres Cathedral, and major churches and cathedrals in England during choir tours given by the choir of the University of the South) under the direction of Robert Delcamp and the Princeton Singers, under the direction of John Bertalot.
