Lawrence DePasquale is a graduate of Glassboro State College, where he studied organ with Dennis Elwell, choral conducting with Clarence Miller, and music education research with Lili Levinowitz. He also holds a diploma from Music Together, an internationally-practiced curriculum for the development of musical skills for young children. He holds the Colleague performance certificate from the American Guild of Organists.

A retiree from full-time employment at Rowan University where he was advisor for 11 undergraduate music programs and coordinator of field experiences for the music education, he continues occasionally returning to the faculty while in his 24th year conducting the 48 voice chorus of Rowan College of South Jersey, and is an ordained deacon of the ELCA currently serving St. John the Evangelist Episcopal Church in Chews Landing as music director.
